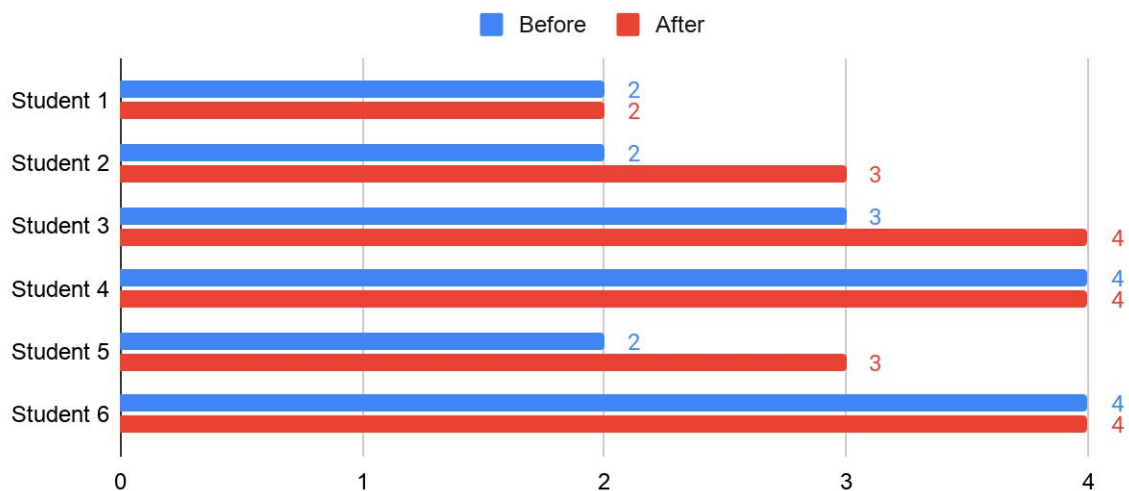


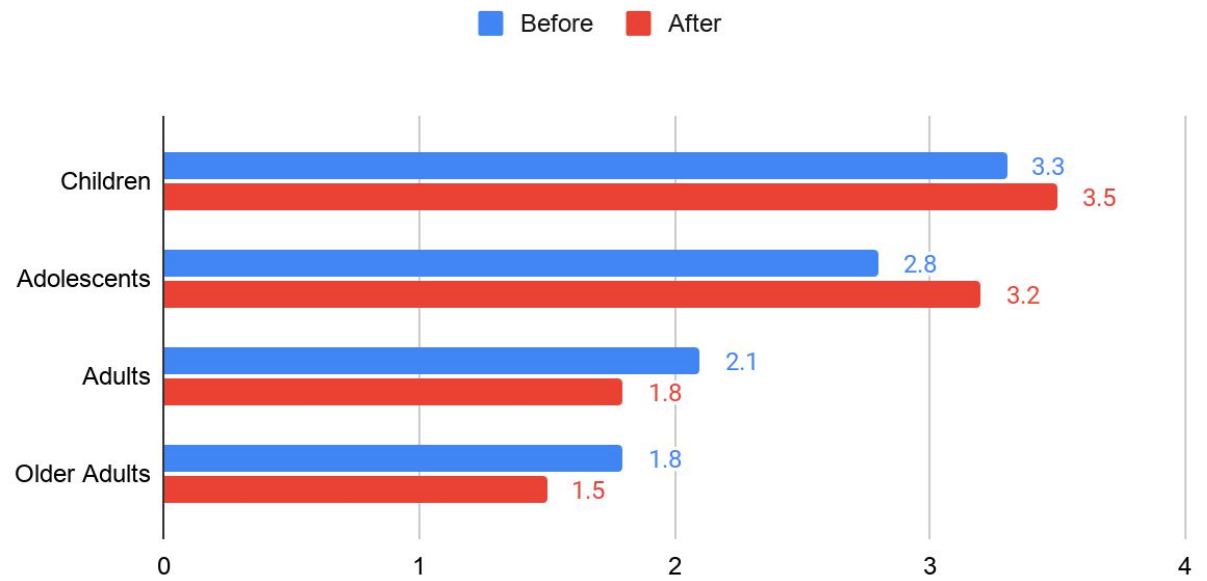
### GRN Follow-Up Survey Summary

- A survey was distributed in September 2020 to 13 students enrolled in Dr. Kaye's Gerontology 500 course as part of the AgingME GWEP social work practicum
- Seven students responded to the GRN follow-up survey in January 2021, answering questions regarding their interest in working with older adults and knowledge of gerontology after completing the course
- Overall student interest in working with older adults after graduation rose slightly after taking the course; three students selected being Extremely Interested in working with older adults in their future careers, while three were Very Interested
- Students were asked to rank the age-specific populations they would prefer to work with from 1 to 4, with 1 being their first choice and 4 being their last choice; after taking the course, 3 students chose Older Adults as their first choice to work with, while 3 chose Adults as their first choice
- Student knowledge rose on average across all competencies after taking the course, including Distinguishing concepts and theories of aging from a bio-psycho-social framework, Demonstrating knowledge of signs, symptoms and impact of common cognitive and mental health problems in late life, and Assessing and reflecting on one's work in order to continuously learn and improve outcomes for older persons.
