



## Mass Spectrometry Analysis Workshop

Wednesday, July 14, 2021 9:00am - 4:30pm UNH - Parsons Hall

The one-day workshop is suitable for beginners and those familiar with applications of Mass Spectrometry in biological and environmental sciences. Topics include MS fundamentals, ionization, instrumentation, sample preparation techniques, MS-based proteomics and sample molecule analysis. Participants will have opportunity to interact with experts in MS at UNH and gain hands-on experience with their submitted samples.

The program will also include tours and demonstrations of various mass spectrometry instrumentation facilities as well as the University Instrumentation Center showcasing a variety of analytical instrumentation. There will be an opportunity to provide a select number of samples for evaluation during the event. Information for this will be collected during the registration process.
