He has authored over 475 peer-reviewed publications as well as more than 30 book chapters and four books. Dr. Rosen has had continuous NIH funding for 25 years and is known as an outstanding mentor for student trainees. His work focuses on the role of fat and bone in regulating whole body metabolism.
