The MHIR Summer Undergraduate Program offers undergraduates a unique opportunity to conduct research in diverse clinical and biomedical science fields during the summer months. During the ten-week program, students participate in mentored, independent research projects either in our state-of-the-art research facility in Scarborough, or working with physicians in a hospital setting to impact patient care or the outcome of treatment. Students also attend lectures and workshops featuring topics including bioethics, animal use in biomedical science and scientific presentation skills, as well as the opportunity to attend presentations by guest scientists and MHIR faculty. Summer Students become employees of MaineHealth and are paid at an hourly rate of \$17 per hour. Students work approximately 40 hours per week for the 10 week period, From June 5, 2023– August 11, 2023. Students are responsible for their own transportation and housing.
