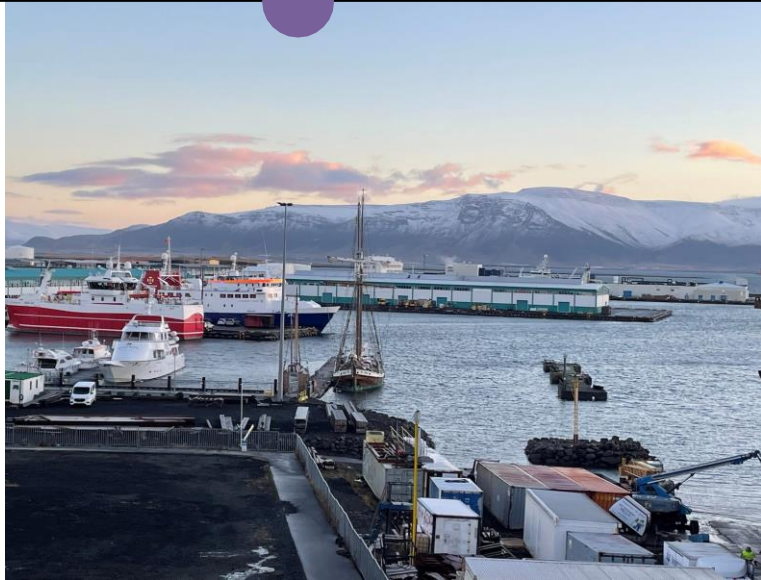


The Impact of Climate Change on Ocean and Human Health in the North Atlantic and Arctic Regions
