- KH: Discussed Strategic Planning presentation of Priority 3 in December 2022 to senior leadership. UNE leadership expects progress from RC in process after study groups report.
- ED: Students' research activities in the humanities involve mentoring in the classroom, which is not recognized as much as student researchers and their mentors in lab settings. These non-lab projects are not well represented in the student research news. In addition, the data about student research at UNE is very old and questionable.
